As you already know, the International MMA Federation (IMMAF) and the World Mixed Martial Arts Association (WMMAA) have announced an amalgamation that will see the global unification of the sport of MMA. An amalgamation agreement was reached between the heads of both organisations on 16 January and approved at General Assemblies held by each party on 25 March and 10 April respectively. The move is essential to MMA's bid for sport recognition within the Olympic sport movement.

**We are delighted to inform you, that Fédération Luxembourgeoise de MMA (FLMMA) is now the only MMA federation in your country recognised by the amalgamated International Federation.**

The decision to recognise your national federation is based on recognition targets being met, in accordance with membership criteria set at an international level by the Global Association of International Sport Federations (GAISF) and standards of good governance.
